Description of Work

General Statement of Duties

Under general supervision, performs bench, machine and hand tool work in the manufacture of parts for equipment and machinery; and performs related work as assigned.

Typical Duties Performed

The listed examples may not include all duties performed by all positions in this class.

Sets up, adjusts and operates lathes, planers, milling machines, shapers, drill presses, grinders and other metal working machines.

Welds, presses, cuts, forms, shapes, turns, bends and performs other operations necessary to finish metal parts.

Makes parts and fittings from drawings, blue prints, rough sketches or oral instructions.

Overhauls miscellaneous machines, equipment and mechanical appliances.

Minimum Qualifications

Eighth-grade education and four years of apprenticeship as a machinist.
