

# Fall Protection OSHA Standard:

29 CFR 1910 Subpart D – Walking-Working Surfaces 29 CFR 1910 Subpart F – Powered Platforms, Manlifts, and Vehicle-Mounted Work Platforms 29 CFR 1926 Subpart M – Fall Protection

This document presents a brief overview and summary of the official written program. The official program is a comprehensive guide to assist District staff in complying with the requirements of the OSHA standard.

### **PROGRAM OBJECTIVE:**

The Saint Paul Public School Fall Prevention Program provides guidelines to be followed whenever an employee works at heights above four feet. These guidelines are established to provide a safe working environment, and to govern the use of fall protection measures and equipment.

#### PROCEDURES:

### **General Requirements**

• ESG responsible for communicating and implementing all aspects of the program.

## **Employee Training**

- Fall protection training will be provided to all personnel who use fall protection devices at SPPS. Such training shall be provided before working at elevated locations.
- Re-training is required whenever:
  - There is a change in workplace that renders previous training obsolete.
  - Changes in the type of fall protection systems or equipment used render training obsolete.
  - Inadequacies in an affected employee's knowledge or use of fall protection systems or equipment indicate that the employee has not retained the requisite understanding or skills.

## **Equipment:**

- Each employee who uses the equipment must conduct a pre-use inspection of fall protection equipment before use as keeping equipment in good working order is essential.
- o Only harnesses provided by ESG are to be used.
- o If there is no passive fall protection such as guardrails or hole covers on a roof and the employee intends to work within 10 feet of the edge of the building a personal fall arrest system must be used.
- $_{\odot}$  Inspect integrity of anchor points before using as a tie off location, it must be capable of supporting at least 5,000 pounds.

## Reporting:

- Employees must report all accidents and near misses that they witness or incur.
- Employees are to report any concerns related to fall protection to their immediate supervisor.
