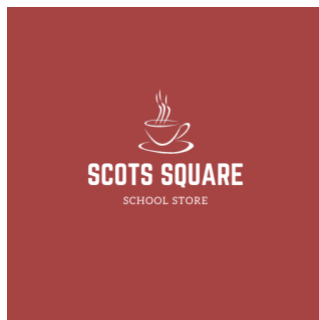
Sponsoring Interns:
