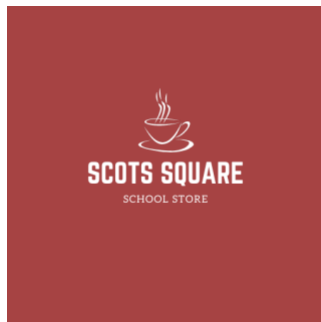
- Highland Heritage Project: interviewing/writing/sharing Highland’s heritage
