

Prom Information

1. Who is allowed to go to Prom?
Juniors and Seniors and their one Junior, Senior or Graduate guest (age 20 years or younger) with a guest slip completely filled out.
2. When and where is Prom?
Please check the JHS webpage, at the Science Museum of Minnesota.
3. What time is Prom?
Prom is from 8-11 pm, you must be at the Science Museum by 9 p.m., no one will be allowed in after 9 p.m. (only people with tickets will be admitted in).
4. How much does Prom cost?
Each ticket is \$40.00 cash only, there is also a charge to park in the Science Museum parking ramp- please call them the week before for pricing.
5. When can I buy the ticket?
The week before Prom in Room 2115, before school (8-8:25) or after school (3-3:30). NOT during classes. Make arrangements to get your ticket(s) that week and before or after school.
6. What do I need when I buy tickets?
The money and each person's first name, last name and the CIF number for any Johnson High School students. Anyone can buy your ticket(s) for you if they have the proper information. No CIF number = No ticket.
7. What do I need to do to buy a ticket for my non-JHS guest?
You need to have a guest slip fully filled out when you buy the ticket. No guest slip= No ticket for a non-JHS student. You can pick them up outside of Room 2115. Do NOT wait until the week of Prom to get it filled out.
8. What else can I do at the Science Museum?
You are able to go into the exhibits for free BEFORE you go to the dance. Check in at the Box Office and they will give you a wrist band for FREE that will allow you to go into the exhibit, once you are done please join us at the dance.
9. What about the Grand March?
The Grand March starts at 5pm (get in line by 5pm so that you do not miss out) in the JHS Warren G. Burger Auditorium. Bring your friends and family so that they can take pictures.
10. What do I need to bring with me for the Dance?
You must have your ticket and ID to get into the dance.
NO ticket or ID = NO entrance into the dance AND no refund
11. Can I leave the dance and then get back in?
No, once you leave the dance you can not come back in.
12. Where can I leave my coat, purse, bag, etc?
There will be a coat check, NO coats, purses, bags etc. are allowed in the dance area, so plan ahead. You will be given ½ of the slip to use to claim your stuff when you are ready to leave.
13. When are we able to get ready for Prom?
On the day of Prom, you will be excused after 2nd period. You must be at school both periods unless you are not normally at school then (ex: PSEO, OJT, Senior Release).
