1. Welcome

5. Treasurer Report

 - Commented on special one-time expenses
 - Shared that we haven't been carrying insurance the last couple of years and proposed that we add it to the budget

 - It was recommended that the budget be posted online
- There was some discussion on the Apex Fun Run and what the future could look like during Covid some ideas included holding it later in this year so it's outside or trying the other options that Apex offers
- A motion was made and seconded to approve the budget including the addition of insurance.

6. Principal's Report

- Principal Lightner reported that the school is full of energy and fully staffed. She also shared a few other key updates:
 - o Ms. Lake is teaching Social Studies
 - Support staff still needed for special education
 - o Mrs. Lightner is getting to know students socially and academically
 - New this year are What I Need Now (WINN) teachers Ms. Martin is helping with an extra boost of reading
 - Mr. Fox is still the reading and math interventionist with other parent volunteers
 - Our classrooms could still expand could possibly get more students
 - o First student COVID case confirmed this week
 - Teachers have really pulled back on iPad usage in classrooms this year but now that students are quarantining iPads may return again
 - For quarantining, GPE is following MDH guidelines
 - o If you are at home, sending home worksheets, books, packets as needed
 - o Still call Groveland if your kids are out call the office to clear your kids if needed
 - Extended Day Leaning is returning Lego League, Learning through Games, and possibly band
 - Open to feedback and questions <u>sarah.lightner@spps.org</u>
- A parent asked if there has been any talk about Afghan refugees coming to Groveland? Mrs.
 Lightner said there is a strong desire to work with the community to get them more support and she will follow up.
