The following is important information on what families need to do to ensure their child is ready for Pre-Kindergarten.

## Health Conditions:

Notify the Licensed School Nurse (LSN) assigned to your child's school if your child has a health condition or takes medication during the school day. The school nurse will work with you to create a health plan for your student.

#### Immunizations:

State law (MS 121A.15) requires that each student enrolled in a Minnesota school be protected from childhood diseases by receiving immunizations. Parents/guardians may obtain a legal exemption for medical reasons or conscientious beliefs.

## The following immunizations are required to start Pre-Kindergarten:

- Hepatitis A 1 dose
- Hepatitis B 3 doses
- DTaP/DT 4 doses
- Polio 3 doses
- MMR 1 dose (after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday)
- HIB 1 dose (after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday)
- Varicella 1 dose (after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday)

### Early Childhood Screening

Early Childhood Screening (ECS) is a program that helps to identify health and developmental needs of young children before they enter Kindergarten. The screening includes vision, hearing, height, weight, development, speech, social/emotional, and review of health and immunization information. The screening is required by <u>law</u> for entrance into Kindergarten in Minnesota Public Schools.

Screening is offered by appointment at the Student Placement Center, 2102 University Ave. W. (University at Cleveland), mornings and afternoons, five days a week. Appointments can also be made for the Hub@Harding, 1526 Sixth St. E. ((located on north end of Harding; enter parking lot off of 6<sup>th</sup> St., Door #20).
