Harding Knight Navy

The "Knight Navy" - Harding's Naval Junior ROTC unit is currently participating in a "Vietnam War Pushup Challenge" to commemorate the sacrifice of the 58,318 names on the Vietnam Memorial Wall in Washington DC. The event started on December 1 and will continue until May 31 (Memorial Day). The initial goal was for the cadets to collectively do a pushup for each name on the wall – 58,318. With 60 cadets and one instructor participating, this number was surpassed on January 8. The current pushup tally as of February 5 is 95,819 and counting. By May 31, we anticipate completing four times the initial pushup target of 58,318, which is 233,272 pushups. Bravo Zulu (well done in navy parlance) cadets! and keep it up.
