Here is a quick diagram to remind you of your gig line. Remember that the rounded edge of the belt buckle is the part that should connect the front fold of your shirt and the fly of your pants. The silver tip of the end of the belt should not farthest away from the gig line; there should be no blue belt material between the belt buckle and the tip of the belt, it should be metal to metal, but the metal frame from behind the belt buckle (where the oval cut out is) should not be visible either.

NOTE: Male metal tips will be to the wearer's left Female metal tips will be to the wearer's right
