### Badminton!

We are the FAUS badminton team of 2023! This has been our journey of the season so far! Although many of us are on different levels, we all have one thing we all enjoy and that is badminton! Read more for what badminton is about!

The culture of badminton comes from many different cultures like China, Greece and India. In 1973, it was officially named when it was first played in 1873, the country estate of dukes of Beaufort in Gloucestershire, England. This game is quite similar to the children's game battle done and shuttlecock. It has come from this game Poona which was played by those officers stationed in India around the 1860's. The first championships were held in 1899 and the women's championship was the year after. Badminton has become quite popular in Malaysia, Indonesia, Japan and Denmark. There are now many different championships for certain countries.

In badminton, you will play with a racket and a birdie. A birdie is a small cork hemisphere with 16 goose feathers which weighs about 5 grams. Overtime, the birdie has been simplified. In badminton. You will play singles or doubles. Singles play by themselves with another opponent on the court. In doubles, you will play with a partner against 2 opponents. The doubles court is different compared to the singles court; the singles court is a 44x17 and the doubles court is a 44 by 20. The doubles court will be playing a wider court while singles will be playing a narrower court. Initially, you will be playing best out of three. You must score 21 to win a set, initially winning by two. If a team were to win 2 sets in a row, there is no need for a third set. This game consists of rallies and smashes meaning that the birdie will go back and forth over the 5 foot net until hitting the ground, which will become a point depending on the circumstance.

Farnsworth Badminton team is filled with community and discipline. Although we should have fun, we must also focus and train hard to be successful in our games. We train Monday - Friday from 4:15 pm to 5:45 pm. In our daily practices, we make sure to set up the nets together as a team, and make sure that we are fully warmed up! As of recently, we have started a more intense conditioning which is running 1 - 2 laps around school to improve our stamina (energy). We have started the season strong with a lead of 5-1, meaning we have won 5 schools and lost 1 school. Not only that, we have recently placed second in the Badminton tournament at Washington Tech Magnet High school! Our goal is to finish off strong, learn new things, have fun, and end this season with many victories!

# SEGREGATION INFOGRAPHIC BY A.H., GRADE 7

## Dr Martin Luther King Jr.

Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. was born in Atlanta Georgia. Jan 15, 1929. He died April 4, 1968. He began school when he was 5 years old. He skipped two grades and he started college when he was 15 years old. For his first job, he was 25 years old. In 1954, King was a pastor of the Dexter Avenue Baptist Church in Montgomery, Alabama. He was best known for improving the civil right movement by using nonviolent civil protest. He organized and led marches for Blacks' right to vote, desegregation, labor rights, and other basic civil rights.



## Civil Rights

The civil rights movement was a nonviolent social and political movement from 1954 to 1968 in the United States to abolish legalized institutional racial segregation throughout the United States.



## segregation

Enslavement came to an end after the Civil War. It was fought from 1860 to 1865. The war was between the Northern and Southern states. Thurgood Marshall was a famous lawyer. He led a group for Black Americans. They wanted to end segregation. Audrey James and their friends had to use bathrooms that were just for black people. They had to use their own drinking fountains.



## Little Rock Nine

The "Little Rock Nine," as the nine teens came to be known, were to be the first African American students to enter Little Rock's Central High School. Three years earlier, following the Supreme Court ruling, the Little Rock school board pledged to voluntarily desegregate its schools.



## Women's Rights

## Suffrage

"There can be no compromise," Elihu Root said. With this, he voiced a general truth. Precisely the same theory has taught something to enemies of women's suffrage. Women already vote in parts of the United States. This makes women's suffrage for the nation unavoidable. United States is a world leader. This means women must have the right to vote. The sayings of the Declaration were once called "fundamental principles of government." They are now called "American principles" or even "Americanisms."



## Sexism

Women's rights movement touched on every area of women's experience—including politics, work, the family, and sexuality. Friedan spoke of the problem that "lay buried, unspoken" in the mind of the suburban housewife: utter boredom and lack of fulfillment. One demanded immediate passage of the Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) to the U.S. Constitution (to ensure equality of rights, regardless of sex).



## Rights

While NOW (National Organization for Women) focused on issues of women's rights, the more radical groups pursued the broader themes of women's liberation. Although they lacked the kind of coherent national structure NOW had formed, liberation groups sprang up in Chicago, Toronto, Seattle, Detroit, and elsewhere. Middle-class women in the northeast were leaders in this new understanding of family life and women.



The changes emphasized equality and independence as important values of the United States. These values challenged the traditional idea of family life, where the husband ruled over his wife and children. Instead, a new idea of an equal family life began to spread. It saw husband and wife working as partners, raising a family through love and kindness rather than control.

## Roles

Should men lead American families, or should women? The Second Great Awakening helped shape the answer to that question. A religious rebirth for many Americans, the second Great Awakening caused millions of people to join churches and become more religious. The Second Great Awakening happened mostly between the 1790s and the 1830s.

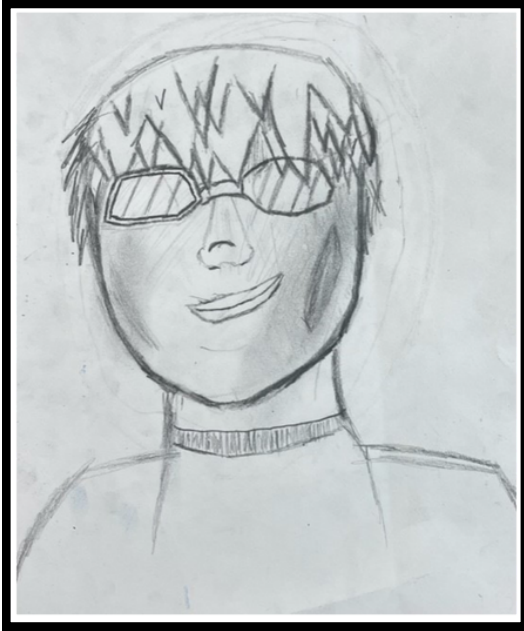
The social forces making America more religious had an especially strong effect on white women. The mostly middle-class women were the main drivers behind the comeback of Christianity.

Jackie Robinson signed to play with the Brooklyn Dodgers in 1947. They paid Jackie Robinson 21000 dollars to join them.



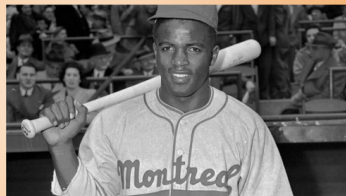
### Breaking the color barrier

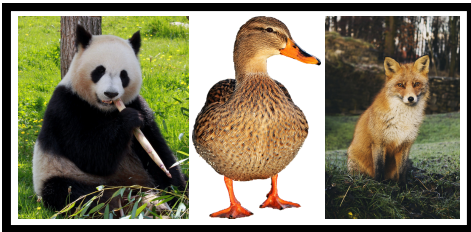
Do you know anything about pandas, ducks or foxes? Let me tell you about it!

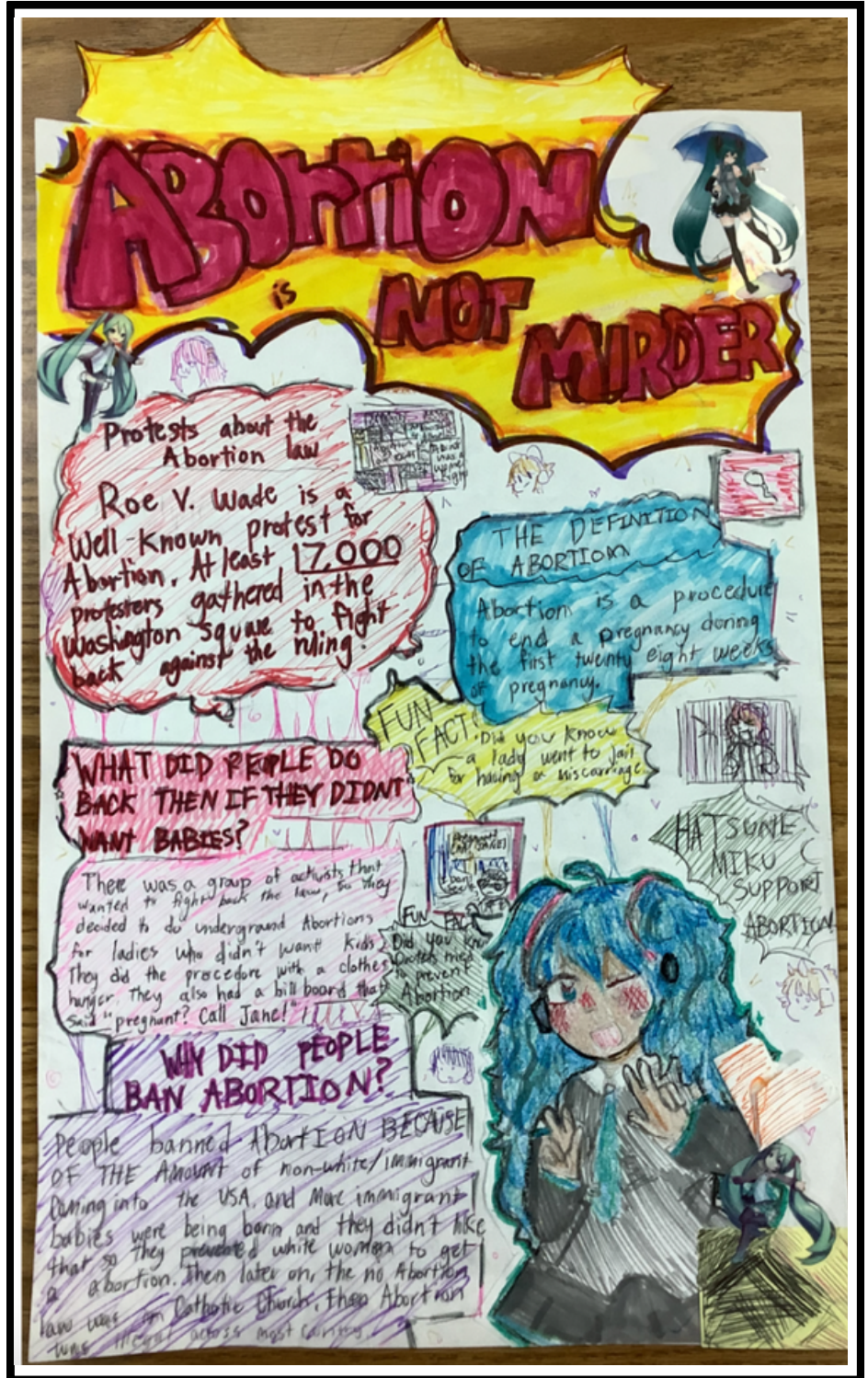

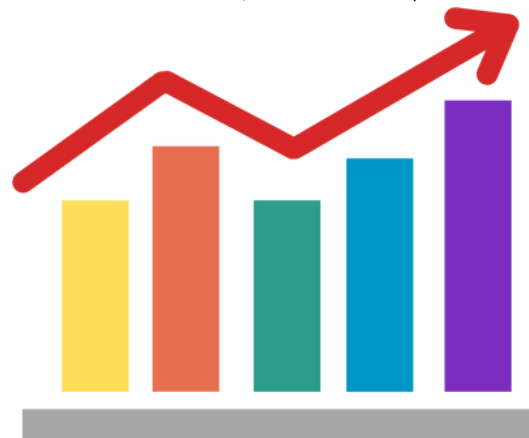


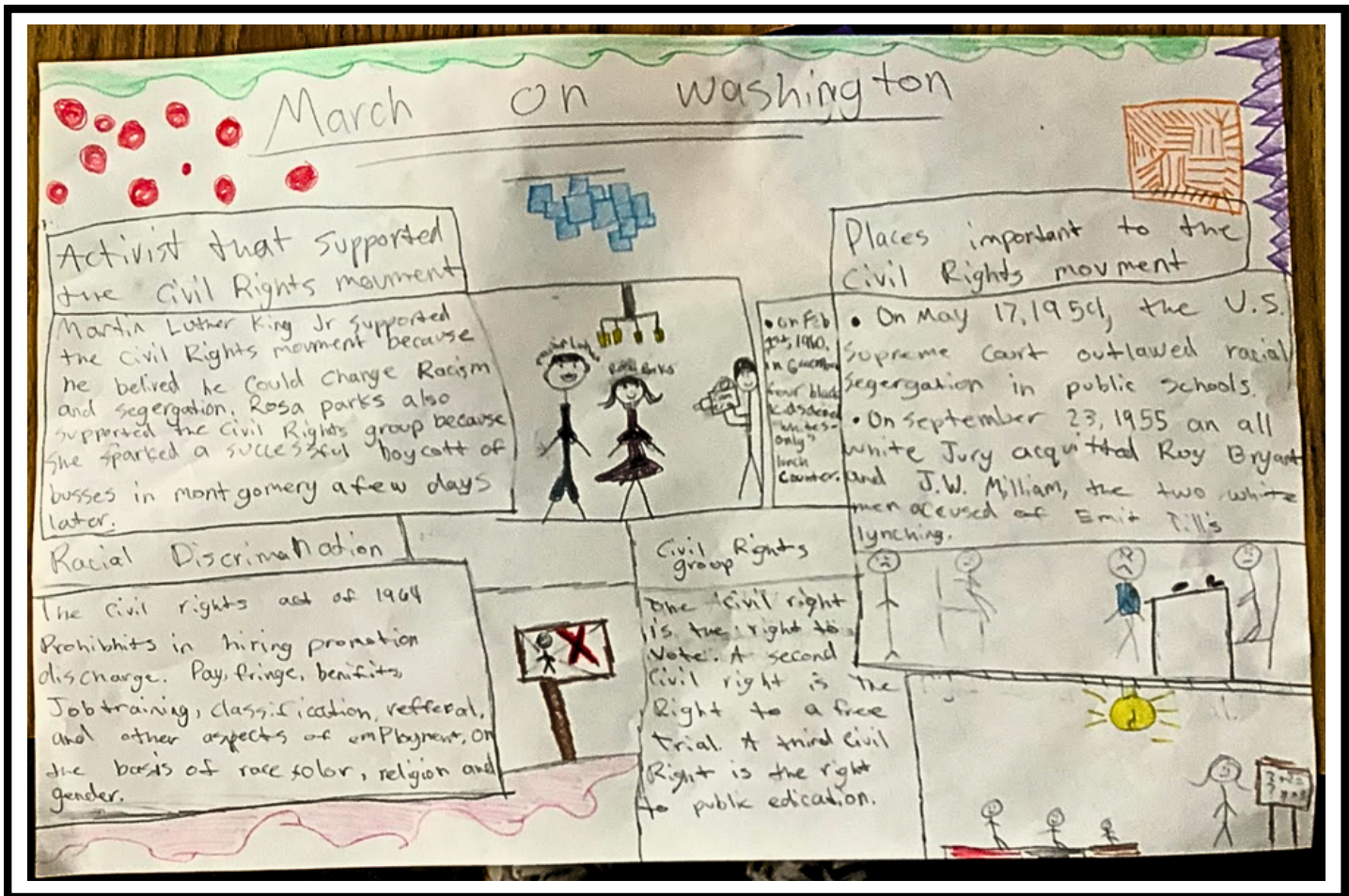

What to do if your experiencing or if someone close to you is experiencing domestic abuse

### What is domestic abuse?

Domestic abuse is the action in which one person in a household will do some form of abuse to gain control over another person in the household, hence the word "domestic." Domestic abuse can come in many forms.



### What are the different forms of domestic abuse?

There are many forms of domestic abuse, but the main four are verbal (or emotional) abuse, physical abuse, psychological abuse, and sexual abuse. Verbal abuse is when you or someone you know goes out of their way to make you feel bad with words. Examples are: bringing up something your insecure about, calling you names. Physical abuse is when you or another person you know is harming you physically. Examples are: pulling your hair, punching you. Psychological abuse is when you or another person you know is trying to be in control of you mentally. Examples are: gaslighting you, intense praise followed by verbal abuse. Sexual abuse is when you or someone you know is doing sexual acts on another person in your household without their consent. Examples are: touching your privates, filming you naked, forcing themselves onto you.

### Why can't they just leave?

There can be many reasons why someone just can't leave their home. One of the reasons may be because of psychological abuse. They might feel as though they are crazy or overreacting for leaving (these are symptoms of psychological abuse). Another might be because of their kids or friends. They might be scared to leave some of their kids behind (siblings, parents, etc). Another reason might be because they have no where to go after they leave. Statistics show that most people who leave end up homeless.

Over 4 million people are living in a household that has experienced domestic violence



### How can I help?

You can help by identifying the signs first so that you can stop it before it gets worse. You can provide support for victims, call Child Protection services (CPS), domestic abuse hotline, or the police. You can provide a shelter for those who ran away.



### All types of domestic abuse should be respected

Lately police have stopped intervening with emotional abuse victims because they say "its not abuse." This is wrong. Emotional abuse can still have long lasting terrible effects on a human brain just like the other types of abuse. As a human it is your job to help, and support other humans.

#### SYMPTOMS OF VERBAL/EMOTIONAL ABUSE:

- Too scared to speak their mind, or really to speak at all
- Tends to overthink before saying or doing anything
- Low confidence and self worth.
- Distrust of others
- Harder to form healthy bonds with other people
- PTSD
- Seeking clarification



Myth: Domestic violence only affects women.

Fact: 85% of men domestic violence victims are men.

#### SYMPTOMS OF PHYSICAL ABUSE:

- Bruises showing up quite a lot
- Broken bones often
- Bald spots in hair
- Bad body odor, just doesn't clean up themselves
- Extremes in behavior (demanding, aggressive, breakdowns, intense crying, etc)
- Sleep disorders
- Seems to overreact



#### SYMPTOMS OF SEXUAL ABUSE:

- Hickeys
- Sexually promiscuous.
- Developmental age-inappropriate sexual play and/or drawings.
- Insecure about body or bad body image
- Being secretive.
- Sharp changes in mood or character.
- Having money or things they can't or won't explain.
- Physical signs of abuse, like bruises or bleeding in their genital or anal area.



#### SYMPTOMS OF PSYCHOLOGICAL ABUSE:

- Feelings of confusion
- Frequent crying
- Post-traumatic stress disorder.
- Misusing alcohol or drugs.
- Blames themselves
- Bad sense of self worth

### Women's Suffrage

#### Women's Suffrage

1. On the Election Day in 1920, millions of women voted for president for the first time. They voted for Warren G. Harding. Before that, no woman in the U.S had the right to vote for president. Only men could vote.
2. For 100 years, women have been fighting for their rights.
3. During early history, women were denied some key rights enjoyed by men. For example, women did not have the right to vote. They were expected to give their attention to housework and motherhood, not politics.
4. The women spent long hours standing on street corners and in public parks making speeches about suffrage. Alice Burke commented that they were in the sun so often that they let their "noses blister and burn" and their "hair sizzle."



#### Past Laws

1. During the Women's Suffrage Movement, the past laws got into their way of getting rights. The 13 colonies made laws that women could not vote.
2. Voting fraud and abuses were common in the colonies and large landowners would grant temporary freeholds to landless men who then handed the deeds back after voting.
3. The following groups of people were not allowed to vote. All slaves and women, most Jews and Catholics, including men who were too poor to be freeholders. The colonial electorate consisted of perhaps only 10 percent to 20 percent of the total population.



#### Gaining rights

1. Women started gaining rights on August 18, 1920. The 19th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution granted women the right to vote. Women fought for the right to vote for a very long time. Tennessee played an important role in helping to pass the 19th Amendment.
2. By March of the following year, a total of 35 states had approved the amendment. To reach a two-thirds majority, one more state needed to approve it.
3. On November 2, 1920, more than 8 million women across the U.S. voted in elections for the first time. It took over 60 years for the remaining 12 states to approve the 19th Amendment. Mississippi was the last to do so, in 1984.



#### Women's Rights Leaders

1. Stanton joined together with another activist named Susan B. Anthony. They formed the National Woman Suffrage Association (NWSA).
2. That same year, Lucy Stone and Henry Blackwell founded the American Woman Suffrage Association (AWSA).
3. In 1890, the NWSA and the AWSA merged together. They formed a new group called the National American Woman Suffrage Association (NAWSA). This group planned to push for voting rights state by state.



There are many types of animal cruelty that are very harmful to animals, but we will talk about 4 types: How fur poaching affects animals, animal habitats being destroyed, animals being killed because they don't have home and animal cruelty.



#### First we will talk about how fur poaching affects animals

Poaching affects animals by killing them off, which can make them an endangered species. This hurts the environment, which is sad. Poaching has been banned to stop this, but people still do it and break the law.



#### Next we will talk about animal habitats being destroyed

Animal habitats are being destroyed by pollution, like when there's plastic in the sea and animals like turtles get stuck. The habitats are harvested for human consumption and cleared to make way for agriculture and housing. Wildfires also burn down trees and surrounding places in forest that damages the habitat.



#### Animals dying because no home

Animals are getting abandoned a lot each year. 6.5 million dogs, cats, and other former pets are abandoned or lost and enter shelters, which can cause animals hunger, thirst, injuries and diseases. Homelessness exposes dogs and cats to an uncertain fate. Once on the streets, they must fend for themselves.



#### Animal Cruelty as a Whole

Animal cruelty can leave animals hungry. 70 billion land animals are killed for food every year. In total, 55 billion animals are being killed every year.

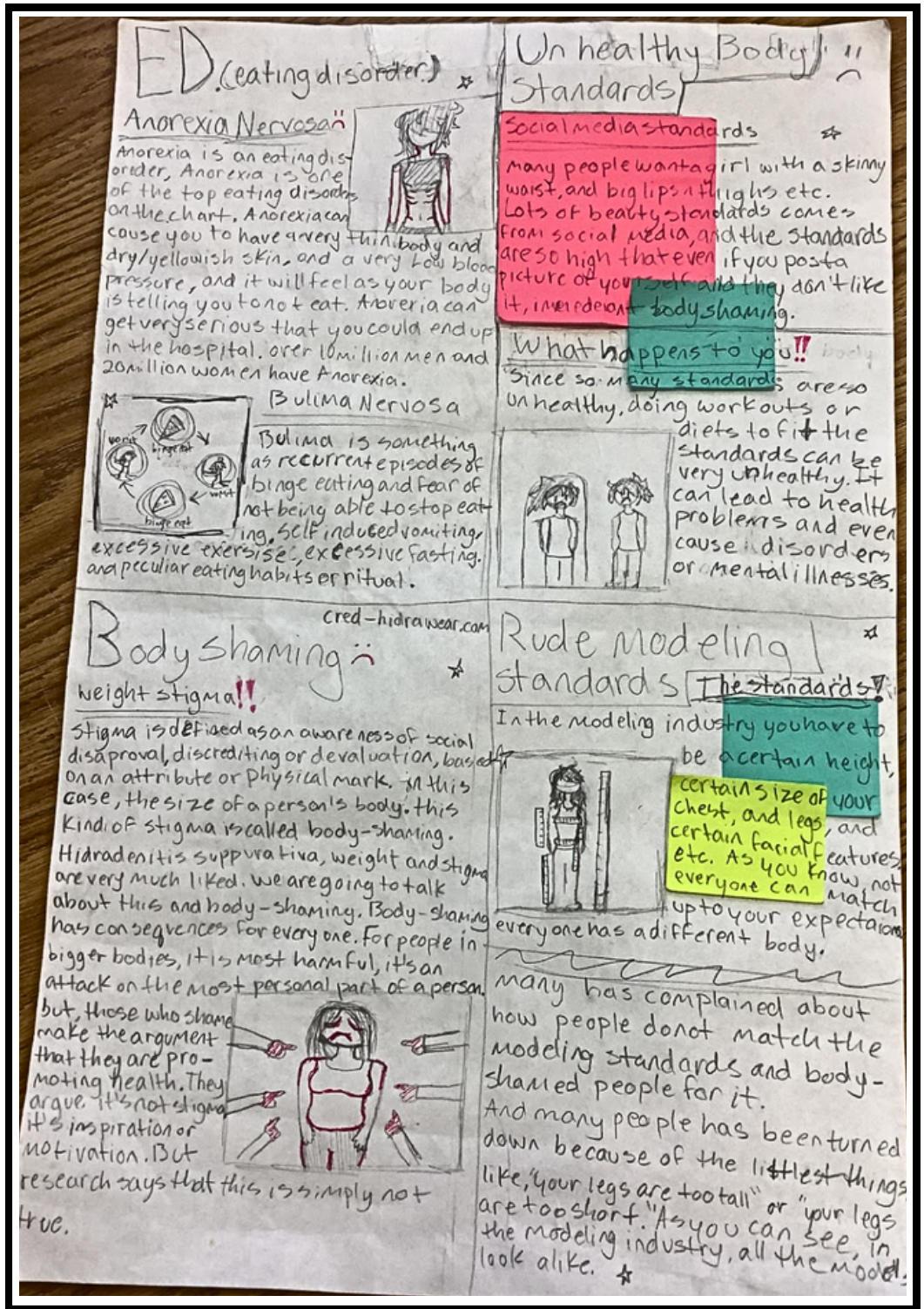
Have you ever tried any Mexican food?

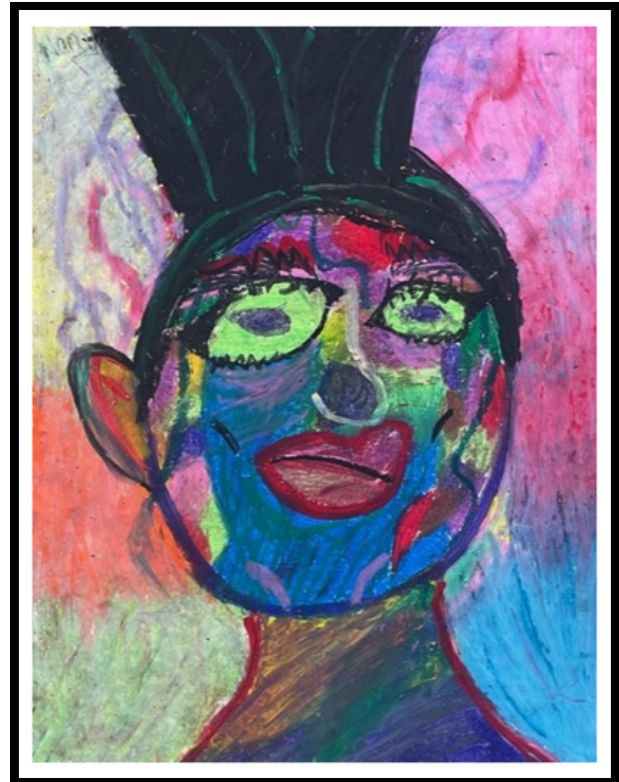

The drugs were OxyContin and opioid pain killers.

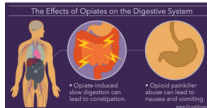

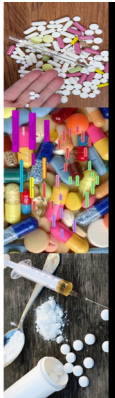
A football team wondered about the absence of a player and later found out he died in his hotel. They found out he died by an overdose.

Drug addiction begins when they take prescribed medicines or receive them from others who have prescriptions.

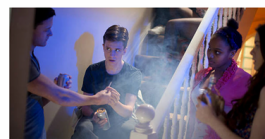


### Why Do People Do Drugs?

Did you know the battle of Bull Run was given two different names, the Union called it the battle of Bull Run after the stream running through the battlefield, while the Confederates named it the battle of Manassas after the nearby town of Manassas.

The battle of Antietam took place on September 17th. The battle of Antietam allowed Abraham Lincoln to declare the Emancipation Proclamation. The battle of Antietam lasted twelve hours and resulted in a Union victory. During the battle of Antietam 23,000 soldiers were either killed, wounded, or missing. The battle of Antietam was the single bloodiest day of the civil war. The battle of Antietam remains the single bloodiest day in the civil war and in American history. General George McClellan was the Union general at the battle of Antietam. The battle of Antietam happened because of General Robert E. Lee's attempt to invade the north.

The battle of Bull Run took place on July 21st 1861. The battle of Bull Run took place in Fairfax county and Prince William county, Virginia. The battle of Bull Run lasted two hours, resulting in a Confederate victory. General Irvin McDonnell led the Union troops to flank the Confederate positions by crossing Bull Run, a river that ran through the battlefield, but were eventually pushed back resulting in a Confederate victory.

The battle of Bull Run resulted in 2,896 casualties for the Union compared to 1,982 casualties for the Confederates. The Union suffered 2,896 casualties of which 460 were killed, on the other hand the Confederates suffered 1,982 of which 387 were killed. The battle of Bull Run, also known as the battle of Manassas took place in Fairfax county, Virginia. The fighting lasted for two hours from 1-3 pm, and the Union retreated from 3-4 pm.

The battle of Gettysburg took place on July 1st 1863. The battle of Gettysburg lasted from July 1st-3rd 1863. The battle of Gettysburg lasted three days and ended on July third 1863. In the three days Gettysburg was fought by an estimated 51,000. The battle of Gettysburg was the most costly multiple day battle. After three days of brutal fighting Union general Meade's army of the Potomac won the battle. Both the Confederate and Union army's were aiming for the Gettysburg junction and collided. An estimated 51,000 soldiers were either killed, wounded, or missing.

**Important facts about woman's rights to vote and woman's suffrage**

Women's suffrage leaders became allies and made incremental steps that led to the passing of the 19th Amendment. The woman's movement expanded to cover African Americans' fight against the Jim Crow laws of the South that were designed to prevent them from voting and other women's rights causes in the twentieth century.

Abolitionist groups such as the American Anti-Slavery Society (AASS), led by William Lloyd Garrison, provided women with opportunities to speak, write and organize on behalf of enslaved people—and in some cases gave them leadership roles.

In the fight for women's suffrage, most of the earliest activists found their way to the cause through the abolition movement of the 1830s.

In the early years of the women's rights movement, the agenda included much more than just the right to vote. Their broad goals included equal access to education and employment, equality within marriage, and a married woman's right to her own property and wages, custody over her children and control over her own body.

After the Civil War, debate over the 14th and 15th Amendments to the Constitution— which would grant citizenship and suffrage to African-American men—inspired many women's rights activists to refocus their efforts on the battle for female suffrage.

## How the Genocide Happened

Between 1933 and 1945, the Nazi regime and their collaborators murdered six million European Jews and five million non-Jews.



## Where it all took place

The Holocaust began in Germany in the 1930s and later expanded to all areas of Nazi-occupied Europe during World War Two.

The majority of killings occurred after the Nazis invaded the Soviet Union. Two years into the war, approximately 6 million European Jews were murdered between 1941 and 1945.



## Who is responsible for it

The primary responsibility for the Holocaust rests on Hitler and the Nazi Party leadership. They lead operations to persecute Jews, Romani people, and homosexuals.



## Historic Timeline in the Holocaust

More Jews lived in Poland in 1939 than anywhere else in Europe. 3 million lived in the Soviet Union.

In December 1939 and January 1940, gas vans equipped with gas cylinders and a sealed compartment had been used to kill disabled people in occupied Poland.

At the end of 1941 in occupied Poland, the Germans began building additional camps or expanding existing ones.

By the spring or summer of 1942, gas chambers had been installed in these new facilities.

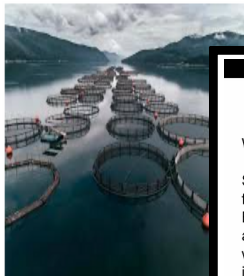
There was almost no resistance in the ghettos in Poland until the end of 1942.

A recent study from the UN shows that aquaculture can improve food security and nutrition by increasing the amount of seafood available for people to eat. If done correctly, aquaculture increases food production, boosts economic growth in coastal and rural areas, and can help keep waterways clean.



## Fish food waste

Where does fish waste go?

Some fish waste is transported for disposal at sea. Environmental concerns associated with disposal of fish wastes into ocean waters include: reduced oxygen levels in the sea waters at the ocean bottom; burial or smothering of living organisms.



## How to protect fish

Why should we protect fish?

Conserving native fish is part of a larger movement to conserve biodiversity on earth. More variety of species leads to better ecosystem services. 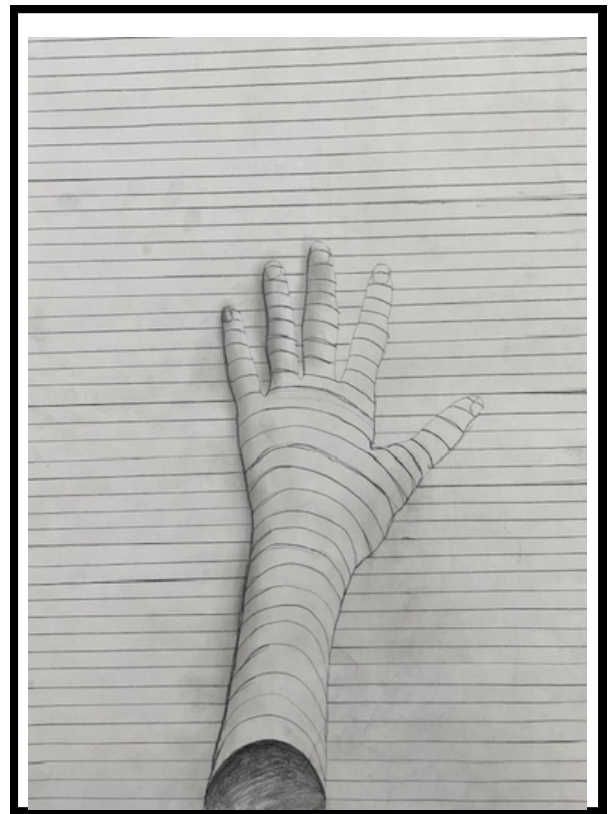

“This is going to be tough,” Said Mario. “But we’ve faced tough challenges before. We can do this!”



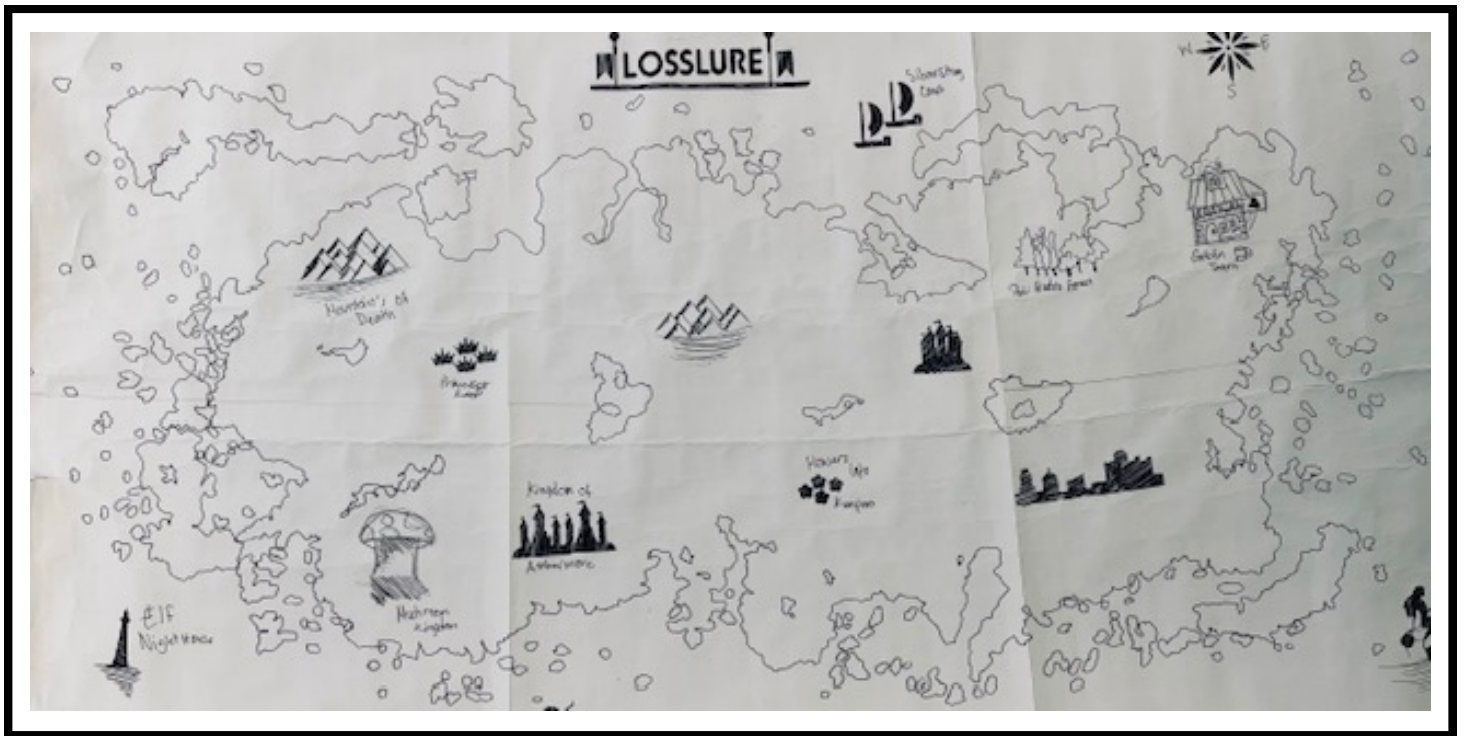
