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English 11 IB is a demanding honors course meeting international standards. Students should be highly motivated, college-bound juniors who are prepared to commit to a course of study which requires independent reading coupled with critical thinking, speaking, and analytical writing. Students are expected to participate daily in our class discussions. Students who do not participate (whether due to not raising hand or absences) will receive a reduced discussion score. 20% of the English IB testing will be accomplished during junior year. Students are expected to create and maintain an electronic Learner Portfolio (Padlet, Google, Wiki) that contains their notes, ideas, and writing assignments. They will use this Learner Portfolio throughout 11th and 12th grades.

In addition to journal and commentary writing, discussions, and small group presentations, students will complete the HL essay which is worth 20% of their IB English score. The essay requires students to construct a focused, analytical argument examining the work from a broad literary perspective. It also requires them to adhere to the formal framework of the academic essay, using citations and references.

After one week, outstanding summatives will marked as 0.
