#### **Overview of Purpose of Community Group**

### **Review of Agenda**

### Principal's Report

- Good start to the year so far. Lots of grounding work (expectations, norms) has been accomplished.
- A lot goes into launching a new school year. The Leadership Team (administration and teachers) develops a plan for the next year the week after the school year ends.
- Doing credentialing this year with EL.
- OWL is a EL mentor school this year (other school is in Idaho).
- Goal with SPPS
  - Increase Math proficiency by 3%
  - Increase Literacy proficiency by 3%
  - Improve student/crew participation in school policies/procedures. For example, students have come up with norms for the school.
- Enrollment is 492 this year highest ever 20 students over projection. Over 100 new students. Dave prefers to start higher and establish flow rather than add students throughout the early weeks of the year.

• New classes for this year: <u>AVID</u>, added another band section, as well as additional theater-related opportunities.

#### **Student Report**

- Year started off HOT!
- Middle schoolers figuring stuff out, being helped by older students.
- New faces in crew and building relationships means a lot to the new students, and to current students.

# **Treasurer's Report**

- The current balance in the PTO checking account at BankCherokee is \$61,650.73
- The current balance in the PTO paypal account is \$4,936.89
- Estimated combined balance is \$66,587.62 (still have a small expense ~\$200 for spiritwear re-order pending)
- Expenses since 5/30: \$829.66 community grants, \$213.20 teacher appreciation, \$4,395.21 spiritwear reimbursement, \$12,000 interim program
- Income since 5/30: \$539.85 donations, \$439 Velazquez Family Coffee fundraiser, \$72.52 from additional spiritwear orders
- The theater program used the PTO paypal account as a passthrough for concessions and 100% of that money was given to the theater program (\$907.43)
- We have budgeted \$25,000 for fall retreats
- We spent \$12,000 on interim expense at the end of 2022-2023 school year but have budgeted only \$10,000 for 2023-2024
- If we are not going to use all of our cash this year, we should consider moving some from checking into CD or money market account to earn 4-5% interest (For example, 4% interest on a \$30,000 deposit is \$1,200 a year)
  - A motion was made to allocate \$20,000 for this purpose. The motion was approved.
- Give to the Max Day is our only large fundraiser for the year and funds the fall retreat. This year it lands on November 16, 2023. In the past we have sent out information in the newsletter, in the physical mail, and on the facebook group
