Principal's Report:

- Facilities Master Plan
 - Parents and students made a trip to Alexandria High School to see school design by project management group responsible for Como's upcoming redesign. Ann C. and Jennifer were on trip and saw many positives and potential in Alexandria H.S. design.
 - Facilities Master Plan meetings will be Tuesday evenings. A goal for design is to tie to academics. The Facilities Master Plan committee will look at flexibility and building relationships and community.
 - A Steering Committee will also be forming to liaison with the project management group and district. There will be a link on Como's website. Their meetings will be on Tuesday mornings.
- Parent & Community Council Meeting is on Tuesday 4/19
 - There will be a presentation on Athletic upgrade. There are dedicated parents and coaches advocating to the Board for Como, which has moved into the first cycle, but ideally the upgrade would happen in sync with the overall Facilities upgrade. While Como will get many needs in Athletics upgrade, not everything will be included. But this makes for a good opportunity for fundraising.
- Budget The board anticipates a shortfall. There will be budget info provided at the Parent & Community Council meeting and Coffee with the Principal.
- Freshman Orientation This Thursday 4/21 and next week Wednesday evening.
