Groveland provides students with a small learning community within complex partnerships of local universities and community organizations, such as the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra CONNECT Program. The programs enable students to have many rich educational experiences. The core courses of math, literacy and science are enriched with music and physical education classes which provide a well-rounded school experience.

We are continually supporting that mission by developing ways to enhance learning for all students. We use the district's SCIP (School Continuous Improvement Plan) to improve our process of improvement.

This year, we have three main areas of focus in our SCIP:

Reading

Teachers will work together during planning time and participate in ongoing literacy training to:

- improve our small group reading instruction.

Math

Teachers will work together during planning time and participate in ongoing math training to:

- utilize small group, differentiated math instruction.

Culture and Climate/PBIS

Teachers will work together during planning time and participate in ongoing Racial Equity training and PBIS training to:

- Continue culturally relevant teaching strategies
- Focus staff strengths on developing interventions through PBIS.
- Continue to reduce the number of office referrals.
