- COVID: Opening week absentee rate between 115-145 absent (not all are necessarily COVID confirmed or related). Absentee rates for the first two weeks back was about 115 out. - Student led conferences in early February will now be virtual.
- We don't know when we'll be out of this, but will re-examine in late February.
- All seniors on track to graduate!

Student Report:

- After coming back from break students are feeling the stress of COVID on teachers and students. It is weighing on everyone.
- Student-led walk out today.

Treasurer Report:

Recent income came from the spirit wear sales (\$1,042.82). Thanks go to Jen Lodahl and Mary Hernandez for leading that fundraiser with Tammy's support! We also received \$750.50 from direct donations through employer matches and Give to the Max.

Anticipated large expenses include up to \$20,000 for the school's Interim program expenses (the school's leadership team is going to discuss this on Thursday), and \$347.50 to reserve the Harriet Island Pavilion for next year's Fall Family Gathering.
