How GPHS is Following Its School Continuous Improvement Plan

GOAL 1: SCHOOLWIDE

100% of students in grades 9-12 will take the Student Climate Survey Fall 2022 and in Spring 2023 with an increase of 10% in student satisfaction as measured by the overall score by June 2023.

Updates:

* The school-wide survey was administered during quarter 1 and results shared with administrators.

* Teacher climate surveys will be given in February.

GOAL 2: MATH

The passing rate for all mathematical courses will increase from 18% (Quarter 4 of 2021-22) to at least 28% in the 2022-23 school year. Actions:

* Teachers are using IXL and Desmos software as classroom tools.

- * Using the software, teachers can identify and address students' needs.
- * Students can accelerate credit earning through participation in Project Based Learning (PBL).

GOAL 3: READING

The total passing rate for all ELA courses will increase from 63% (2021-22 average passing rate per quarter) to at least 73% in the 2022-23 school year. Actions:

* Common Lit app is used to target reading to students' ability levels.

* Reading/Writing Workshop model gives our ELA teachers the ability to address individual student's needs.

* Students can accelerate credit earning through participation in Project Based Learning (PBL).
