

Visual Art IB

- open to all 10th, 11th and 12 graders, regardless of past art experiences
- 2 years of Visual Art IB are required to take the IB exam

IB Diploma Level (DP) Visual Art

Open to 10th, 11th, and 12th graders. Two full years are required to take the art exam.

Students develop skills in art from at least two art areas: 2-D, 3-D, and lens-based

Investigate artists, materials, and cultures while developing original portfolios, workbooks, & comparative studies.
