Principal's Report-

• Target Spotlight Grant Update– our site visit went well, 10 - 100,000 grants will be awarded, 30 schools chosen metro area, we should hear in about 2 weeks

• The grant will be used to rebuild our Academic Behavior Support Center - we will give more time for tutorials and mentoring, we will train all teachers in restorative justice, we will train the community and parents as well

• Coffee with the Community is next Tuesday, April 21, from 9:00 - 10:00, there were 9 community members present at the last coffee

• Thompson Roters is forming a partnership with Como High School for the next school year.

• We have a new partnership with Prudential, some business students will spend a day at Prudential on May 15

• School and Community Council meeting is Tuesday, April 21, from 6-7:30, we will discuss the school's Scip Plan, budget, and update on facilities master plan

• New Grading Policy is being implemented this quarter, to receive accreditation Como needed to implement a uniform grading system, it will be revisited and revised in the fall

• School Budget – next year we will need to cut approx. \$800,000, Title 1 is decreased by 6%, the legislature is holding back money, the last contract negotiated for teachers, required more librarians, counselors, and nurses in the building, PLC for teachers is

embedded in school day, 6 -7 positions in the building will be cut

• Principal Neal will consider climate in the building as well as safety and security, academic performance when looking at these cuts

• Como needs to submit it's budget to the district on the April 24 and staff has to be notified by May 1 of any changes, the School Board will vote on the budget at their June 16 meeting

• Como's student population is 74% free and reduced lunch and we are considered a low poverty school, 75% is considered high poverty

• The Leadership Team will discuss at their retreat Como's prioritized needs and how to brand and market Como High School, Princiapl Neal invites all stake holders to be a part of the discussion

• Freshman registration dates are April 22 and 28, at 6:00 PM
