# What is Early Childhood Special Education Community Inclusion?

- A Preschool-aged children are eligible for our services based on an evaluation that shows a delay in development
- $\stackrel{\scriptstyle \star}{\sim}$  We provide a range of services based on a child's development and learning needs
- $\stackrel{\scriptstyle \ensuremath{\notlambda}}{\sim}$  We help children be successful in their home and community
- A Services are provided at preschool and childcare including Head Start, Early Childhood Family Education, private preschools, or your home
- $\precsim$  All children have the right to belong and participate in typical activities in their communities



### **Early Childhood Special Education Services**

- ☆ Our services: ☆ Are **free** 
  - $\stackrel{\scriptstyle <}{\curvearrowright}$  Have no waitlist for eligible children
  - $\stackrel{\circ}{\not\sim}$  Have no income requirements
  - ☆ Require parent consent
  - $\stackrel{\wedge}{\precsim}$  Do not ask about immigration status
- $\precsim$  We value your home culture and language. Interpreters are used to communicate with families

# What to Expect

- $\precsim$  Children learn best during everyday routines and activities
- $\stackrel{\scriptscriptstyle \wedge}{\succ}$  St. Paul Public Schools 4 year old Pre-K classrooms welcome children with special needs
- $\precsim$  ECSE staff guide families through transitions to preschool programs and kindergarten
- $\precsim$  An Individualized Education Plan (IEP) is written with your family to determine learning goals and the plans for services
- $\stackrel{\scriptstyle <}{\sim}$  Regular progress monitoring about supports needed to reach IEP goals
- $\precsim$  Services are available from a child's 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday until entrance to kindergarten
- $\stackrel{\wedge}{\leadsto}$  Services are provided during the school year





# Primary Service Provider Model

- $\precsim$  One person from our team will be your child's Primary Service Provider (PSP)
- $\stackrel{\wedge}{\leadsto}$  The PSP is chosen based on highest priorities for your child
- Your child's team may include an ECSE Teacher, a Speech and Language Pathologist, an Occupational Therapist, a Physical Therapist, a Social Worker, a Nurse, an Audiologist, a teacher of Deaf/Hard of Hearing, and a teacher of Blind/Visual Impairments
- ☆ Our team helps caregivers and teachers help children learn new skills within daily routines and activities
- $\precsim$  We observe, coach, and problem solve to maximize learning opportunities
