  - B. Currently enrollment is down across school, with the biggest risk in Kindergarten
    - a. 7:30 start time is a big factor in the decrease of prospective students
    - b. Asks the community to help with recruitment and build awareness of the school, this could include
      - 1. Investing in EXPO yard signs
      - 2. Placing an article in the Villager
- Treasurer's update
  - A. Highlights from recent transactions include:
    - a. Several Carnival check requests were paid
      - 1. Still waiting to hear from club choice
    - b. Per BOD, \$20,000 was moved from Silent Auction to Music Residency
    - c. St Thomas deposit (\$1,000) for Silent Auction was paid (March 21st)
    - d. Give to the Max push (Nov. 5 14) \$15,000 was raised, not including matches.
  - B. Playground Account update:
    - a. Since September 27, we have grossed \$50,327.78. After processing fees, we have netted \$49,748.70.
    - b. This already includes the \$10K match we will get sometime this week as well as some other online giving via other platforms (i.e. Benevity, GiveMN) that we might not see in our accounts until later in December (estimating fees that they may charge).
    - c. After everything gets deposited into our account, I anticipate the Playground account balance will be \$75,596.66.
