ACT is March 7, 2023

The ACT will be administered at Como Park in the gym and fieldhouse. If a student has an accommodation, their testing location will be different, and they will be notified prior to the test date. Students should be at school on time; no later than 8:30. Students should bring their student ID, a calculator, a water bottle and/or snack. A snack will also be provided. Cell phones, smartwatches, etc. are not allowed and cannot be accessed at any time. Failure to comply with any of the rules provided by the test administrators may result in test invalidation and student removal. Testing will take approximately 4 hours and lunch will be provided after testing is completed. Students with accommodations may have up to 6 hours for testing.

MCA & MTAS Testing 2022-23

Each spring, the Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments (MCA) or the Minnesota Test of Academic Skills (MTAS) are provided to students in mathematics (grades 3-8 and 11), reading (grades 3-8 and 10), and science (grades 5, 8 and in high school upon completing biology). Most students take the MCA; however, some students who receive special education services and meet eligibility requirements take the MTAS. Both tests provide information about student learning of grade level content in reading, mathematics, and science. The MCA and MTAS are used to meet federal and state legislative requirements. The tests are administered every year to measure student learning relative to the Minnesota Academic Standards that specify what students in a particular grade should know and be able to do.

Students will take the MCA or MTAS between March 6-May 5, 2023. If you would prefer that your student not participate in statewide standardized testing, please inform your student's principal of that choice by providing a written note or a completed MDE Parent/Guardian Participation Guide and Refusal form.

- -I grew up in this area and I've been enjoying returning the gift of education to this community, passing it forward to the students.



Como Senior Alex Le accepts Air Force Academy Appointment

Como Park High School senior Alex Le received nominations to the U.S. service academies from Congresswoman Betty McCollum and Senator Tina Smith last fall.

When Le was appointed to the Air Force Academy, his college search was over.

Le was also appointed to the Naval Academy. He's still waiting to hear from West Point.

But the decisions of the Army and the few other elite schools he applied to won't matter. Le's first choice has al been the Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

As an Air Force cadet, Le's tuition, room and board will be fully funded, and he will receive a \$900 monthly stipend throughout his four years. Upon graduation, Le will serve five years of active duty — which is precisely the plan Le wants to pursue.

"I'm excited to give back through my service," Le said. "I plan to be an aerospace engineer or a pilot."

Le already has a private pilot's license from the Federal Aviation Administration. He achieved that last summer by earning a full scholarship to the Naval Summer Flight Academy at Delaware State University.

Le is the son of Thephong Le and Danglan Nguyen. They migrated from Vietnam to St. Paul in the 1990s. Le attended Crossroads Elementary and Murray Middle School before his high school years at Como.

When asked about his Como experience, Le praised his teachers. "I'm grateful for their commitment. They are hard-working and give each student a chance to accelerate their learning and reach their full potential."

In return, each of Alex's teachers will tell you that he's intellectually curious, motivated, kind and a pleasure to teach. His intelligence is matched by his effort — both are exceptional.

Le has a 4.0 GPA with a weighted GPA of 4.74 from Advanced Placement college-level courses.

Le said he used to be meek and quiet, but his involvement in Como's Marine Corps JROTC program changed that.

"Marine Corps JROTC made me more confident, assertive, and improved my leadership skills," Le said. "I also learned humility and how to work as a team."

Le acknowledged that the new team he will join at the Air Force Academy has a reputation for intensity.

When asked if he's ready for it, Le paused, smiled and said, "Yes I am."

Submit the <u>2022-2023 MSHSL Eligibility Brochure</u> to the Como Park Athletic Office. NOTE: You must completely fill out and upload ALL pages below: • Page 1, Pages 10-11 (Eligibility Statement), Page 12 (Health Questionnaire)

MSHSL Eligibility Brochure only needs to be submitted once per school year.

Step 3

A current sports physical must be on file with the Athletic Department. Sports physicals last for 3 years. You can schedule an appointment for free at the Como Park High School Clinic.

Step 4

Athletic fees are due before the first day of practice.

Please pay by cash or check (made payable to Como Park Athletics).

Fees can be dropped off at the Athletic Office – Room 1109.

This program takes place via Zoom meetings Monday-Friday from 9:00am-12:00pm.


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


