Greetings GAPU 5th grade students and families,

Math: Our current unit focuses on decimals. We will explore the place value of decimals, how to add decimals and how to order decimals on a number line.

Literacy: We have read <u>We Are Water Protectors</u> and <u>Fry Bread</u> written by Indigenous people. It helped students understand more about Native American cultures and how history impacts lives of Native people today. We have also been learning about different kinds of poetry by studying some of the works of Joyce Sidman.

Social Studies: Exploring how Mesoamerican indigenous

civilizations, like the Aztec and Maya, were destroyed by

European conquistadors. Students are learning about the resilience of the indigenous people and how they incorporated their culture into the society that emerged through colonization.

Science: We are starting our first science unit in November! We will explore how matter and energy move through ecosystems. Our unit will explore matter and energy in the Yellowstone National Park ecosystem.
