Welcome to the Spanish Immersion Program at Highland Park Middle School!

A positive and successful experience on the HPMS Spanish Immersion Team is created when students, families and teachers have a common understanding of the expectations and then work together to make it happen!

Students will receive the **maximum benefits** of the immersion program at Highland Park Middle School if they have **strong Spanish literacy skills** and are committed to practicing their *reading*, *writing*, *speaking* and *listening* skills in Spanish **everyday**.

The Spanish Immersion program at HPMS offers many of the core curriculum classes in Spanish (Math, Social Studies/Humanities, Science and Spanish Language Arts). In these immersion classes, all instruction and student work is done in Spanish using the same coursework and level of academic rigor as classes taught in English. For Spanish Immersion students, reading and writing in English will ONLY be taught in the English Language Arts, English Language Learner classes and Readers and Writers Workshop.

In order for students to study math, social studies/humanities, science and *simultaneously* work to improve their level of academic Spanish, we expect students and families to commit to the following:
