Description of Work

General Statement of Duties

Under supervision, finishes walls, ceilings and other surfaces with lime, cement, plasters and other plastic materials; and performs related work as assigned.

Typical Duties Performed

The listed examples may not include all duties performed by all positions in this class.

Uses hawk, trowel, darby, straightedge or rod in applying plastic materials to walls, ceilings, piers, columns or other parts of structures.

Does interior and exterior plastering of cement, stucco, stone imitation or other plastic material.

Levels ceilings and plumbs walls.

Tears down loose plaster, prepares walls and applies new plaster.

Sticks corner beads and plaster ornaments.

Makes moulds and templates.

Prepares surfaces for finishing with terrazzo or tile.

Minimum Qualifications

Eighth-grade education and possession of a certificate evidencing the completion of training as an apprentice plasterer, or four years of experience as a journeyman plasterer. Must possess a certificate of competency issued by the City of Saint Paul.
