Description of Work

General Statement of Duties

Supervises and participates in pipefitting work involved in the installation, maintenance, and repair of steam piping, fixtures, apparatus and accessories for power and heating or for refrigeration or temperature control; performs related work as assigned.

Supervision Received

Works under the general supervision of a unit supervisor.

Supervision Exercised

Exercises moderate supervision over Lead Pipefitters and/or Pipefitters. Provides coordination of workflow to the district's machinist department.

Typical Duties Performed

The listed examples may not include all the duties performed by all positions in this class.

Supervises Lead Pipefitters and/or Pipefitters; provides scheduling and direction for projects; provides coordination of workflow to the district's machinist department.

Prepares reports, estimates and specifications.

Installs steam and hot water-heating plants.

Repairs steam lines.

Packs valves.

Cuts and threads pipes.

Installs, repairs and/or maintains steam and hot water radiators, pipe covering, refrigeration systems, temperature control devices and related equipment.
